Deliverable D8.1 is of nature “Website” and it is accompanied by this document report that provides a short overview description. The website deliverable of COUCH has two parts:


- Public area - Website

The information contain herein is self-explanatory; except maybe for the "STUDENTS" page. This page is used as an active recruitment for University students that are looking for graduation assignments or internships to perform within the context of the Council of Coaches project. An initial poster campaign

was launched to attract students in the Twente area of the Netherlands using the following poster that links to this part of the website (see Figure 2).




Figure 4: Top 5 pages visitor counts Jul-Sep 2017 for (#1) Main Page, (#2) PhD Vacancy Post, (#3) Consortium Page, (#4) CMC, and (#5) RRD partners pages.




Figure 5: Online access of the COUCH file repository.




Figure 6: Access of the COUCH file repository from PC.
